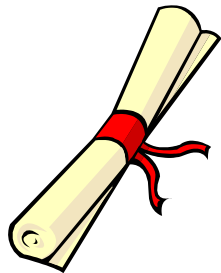


NEWBURY PARK HIGH SCHOOL Majors Program

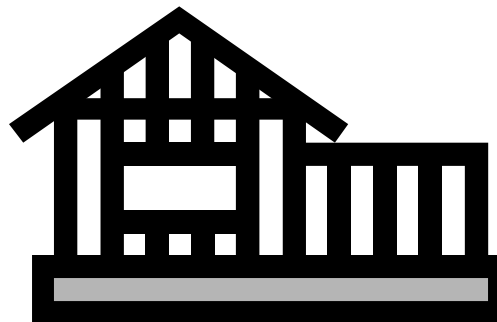

MAJORS PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

Proof of the following requirements must be turned in to the College & Career Center in a folder before students are awarded their Majors Program Certificate.

Informational Interview (1/2 hr.-1 hr.)
Interview a professional in an occupation that interests you.

Job Shadow (2-4 hours)
Observe a professional on the job and tour his/her workplace.

Classes Related to Chosen Major
Complete 30 credits or more with a 'C' or better depending upon the selected Major. See individual brochures in the College & Career Center for more details.

Resume
Highlight your skills and experience on a computer-typed resume.

One of the Following:

Internship (30 hours)
An unpaid job related to your Major, which lets you "try on" a career and helps you acquire new skills.

or

Community Service (30 hours)
Volunteer in a field that relates to your Major.
