Experimental Aircraft Association (EAA) Scholarship

May 1, 2010

Award: varies

Eligibility: Students studying or accepted to study in the following fields: Engineering, Science, Computer Science, or Aviation Technology; residents of Ventura County; possess a GPA of 3.0; enrolled or accepted in an accredited institution of higher learning, i.e. community colleges, colleges, and universities.

Criteria: Completed application, transcript, essay, 2 letters of recommendation, interview. Forms are available in the CCC.

Somis Town and Country Club Scholarship

May 3, 2010

Award: \$1,000

Eligibility: Graduating seniors who are residents of Somis and who are applying at a four-year college, junior college or trade school..

Criteria: Completed application, GPA (3.0 for students applying to a 4-year college, 2.0 for those applying to a junior college or trade school), transcripts, SAT or ACT scores, letters of recommendation. Forms are available in the CCC.

Thousand Oaks-Westlake Village Community Foundation Scholarship

May 7, 2010

Award: \$1,000

Eligibility: Graduating seniors who have been in Work Experience or ROP program, and who will attend a 2 or 4 year institution or vocational/specialty school in the Fall of 2010.

Criteria: A 2.7 GPA or above; employment in the local community while attending classes as a regular student; selection through the Work Experience Program or Regional Occupational Program (ROP); 2 letters of recommendation; essay. Forms are available in the CCC.

Los Primeros School of Science and Arts (LPSSA) Scholarship

May 14, 2010

Award: \$350

Eligibility: Graduating high school students who also graduated from LPSSA, and who are planning to attend a two or four-year college or university.

Criteria: GPA, SAT/ACT scores, extracurricular activities and/or work experience, essay, completed application. Forms are available in the CCC.

Conejo Valley Little League Scholarship

May 16, 2010

Award: \$500

Eligibility: Graduating seniors who have played or umpired in CVLL for at least five years and plan to attend a four-year college or university, junior college, or trade school.

Criteria: Academic achievement, essay, interview, completed application. Forms are available in the CCC.

Camarillo Pony Baseball Association (CPBA) Shannon May Memorial Scholarship

May 21, 2010

Award: \$500

Eligibility: College-bound, graduating high school seniors who have played at least one year in the CPBA.

Criteria: Academic achievement, essay, financial need. Special consideration will be given to those who currently play high school baseball and who plan to continue competing in the sport in college. Forms are available in the CCC.

Boys and Girls Club of Ventura Emma Nysten Trust Scholarship

May 21, 2010

Award: \$100 - \$1,000

Eligibility: Graduating seniors or young men and women who have completed high school, under the age of 30, preferably have been residents of Ventura County at one time, will attend 2-4 year colleges, trade or technical programs, or internships for recreation or childcare/development majors (for students already in college), demonstrate financial need.

Criteria: Completed application, essay, transcript, letter of recommendation. Forms are available in the CCC or at www.bgclubventura.org.

B. Davis Scholarship

May 28, 2010

Award: \$1,000

Eligibility: High school and post secondary school students between the ages of 16 and 30.

Criteria: Essay on the following topic: "Describe the three characteristics of leadership you value most. Discuss whether you believe you possess some or all of these qualities, and describe an experience where you developed and/or demonstrated some or all of these traits." AGC Tri-Counties District Scholarship

May 30, 2010

Award: \$500-\$2,500

Eligibility: Seniors choosing a career path in construction technology, i.e. those who (a) wish to further their education, training, and development in construction related classes at a community College or 4-year University; or, (b) have been accepted in a Certified Apprenticeship Program or any construction trade; or (c) are currently, or will be employed by a construction related trade/field upon graduation.

Criteria: Completed application, 2.5 GPA the last two years of high school, essay, official school transcript, counselor report, 2 letters of recommendation. Forms available at CCC
