CSF Registration for the fall of 2010 is September 20 - October 1

Who can join? CSF membership is open to all students grades 10, 11 and 12 who have met the point requirements on the application. Ninth graders may apply in February 2011 after they have completed their first semester at NPHS. Generally, acceptance requires a 3.3 GPA in academic subjects.

How do I join? When registration is announced in September and again in February, complete the application and bring your five-dollar dues to the **College and Career Center**. You can check your grades on Zangle if you need to. Your grades and points will be verified. The names of those accepted into CSF will be posted on the website and in *Panther Pursuits*. Students must have four semesters from 10-12 one of which must be from their senior year to qualify as a gold seal bearer at graduation.

Is there a CSF club? Students who qualify for CSF also have the opportunity to join the CSF club that meets every other Tuesday in Mr. Martin's room at lunch. The club sponsors several community service projects and activities throughout the year as well as a one-day conference in the spring. If you wish to qualify for the CSF scholarship or the state Seymour Scholarship, you must be an active member of the club.

What is CSF? The California Scholarship Federation, founded in the 1920's, recognizes students' academic accomplishments. At graduation, students who have met the requirements and been a member of CSF for four or more semesters, one of which must be in their senior year, will receive a gold seal on their diploma, a gold tassel to wear at graduation, be acknowledged at Senior Awards Night and become a lifetime member of the CSF organization.
