2010 HIGH SCHOOL SUMMER SCHOOL

The District has adopted the following registration and class enrollment procedures for the 2010 summer school:

LOCATION: THOUSAND OAKS HIGH SCHOOL

2323 N. Moorpark Road, Thousand Oaks, CA 91360-3198

DATES: Monday, June 21 through Thursday, July 29

(No school June 25, July 2, 5, 16, 23,)

First Semester session: June 21, 22, 23, 24, 28, 29, 30,
July 1, 6, 7, 8, 9

Second Semester session: July 12, 13, 14, 15, 19, 20, 21, 22, 26,
27, 28, 29

*All students must be present on the first and last day of each semester.
ANY STUDENT NOT PRESENT ON THE FIRST DAY OF CLASS
WILL BE DROPPED. Final Exams are given the last 2 hours of the final
day of the semester. FINALS WILL NOT BE GIVEN EARLY.*

TIMES: 7:40 a.m. to 1:20 p.m. with two 15-minute breaks from 9:20-9:35 and 11:20-11:35. Classes meet five hours per day.

CONEJO SCHOOLS FOUNDATION - TUITION-BASED CLASSES: There will be a fee for all accelerated (move-ahead) classes. Health is a one semester (3 week) course and the fee is \$250 (on-line and at TOHS); all other classes are \$500.00 (on-line and TOHS).

TRANSPORTATION: will *not* be provided by CVUSD.

SUMMER SCHOOL INFORMATION:

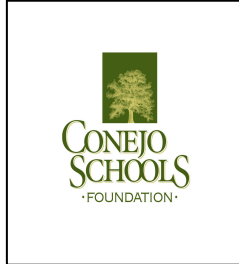
1. A student is only allowed 6 hours of absence (for any reason) per three-week semester to receive credit for the semester class.
2. A student tardy 15 or more minutes is charged with two hours absence.
3. A student tardy less than 15 minutes is charged with a one hour absence.
4. Students taking a year-long class to accelerate (move-ahead) must complete all six weeks (both semesters) of summer school.
5. Students taking English 12, Geometry, U.S. History or World History as a move-ahead class will be granted 10 credits at the completion of the full six weeks. Students are not allowed to take only first semester of a move-ahead course.

2010 HIGH SCHOOL SUMMER SCHOOL REGISTRATION INFORMATION

PRIORITY REGISTRATION: For CVUSD students who are requesting to improve an "F" or "D" grade.

Who: All students with or without a C.V.U.S.D. identification number. Students not currently attending a CVUSD school will be assigned to classes on an availability basis.

Time: Registration for go-ahead classes, either on-line or at TOHS, is from 8:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. on April 24, 2010 at Thousand Oaks High School. A lottery system will be used for classes where there are more requests than seats available. There is no advantage to arriving early. A student does not have to be present for registration; however, the parent/guardian must have the student's identification number available when they register the student for their course. **If paying by check, please put the student's first and last name in the memo section of the check.

Payment: Must be received on April 24, 2010 when you register your student. Acceptable payment options are: Checks, Money Orders, Cash, or Credit Card. (A \$5.00, non-refundable, processing fee is charged for all credit card payments.) No ATM payments will be accepted. Please make checks payable to Conejo Schools Foundation. *There will be a \$25.00 charge for all returned checks (no exceptions).* *Plus, the student will be removed from the class and placed at the bottom of the waiting list.*

Confirmation of Enrollment: On May 3, 2010, rosters will be available at all CVUSD Middle and High School Counseling Offices, in addition to being posted on the CVUSD Website, www.conejo.k12.ca.us Click on the link to summer school to view the class rosters. (Student names will not appear, just student Identification Numbers!)

Refund Policy: Students that are not placed in their requested course will receive a full refund. Students that withdraw from summer school prior to June 1, 2010 will receive a partial refund of 50% of the tuition fee. No Refunds after June 1, 2010. No exceptions. (The \$5.00 processing fee will not be refunded under any circumstances.)
